What is Electrostatic disinfection?

Electrostatic is based on the principle that opposite charges attract and like charges repel.

Two positively charged things will repel each other.

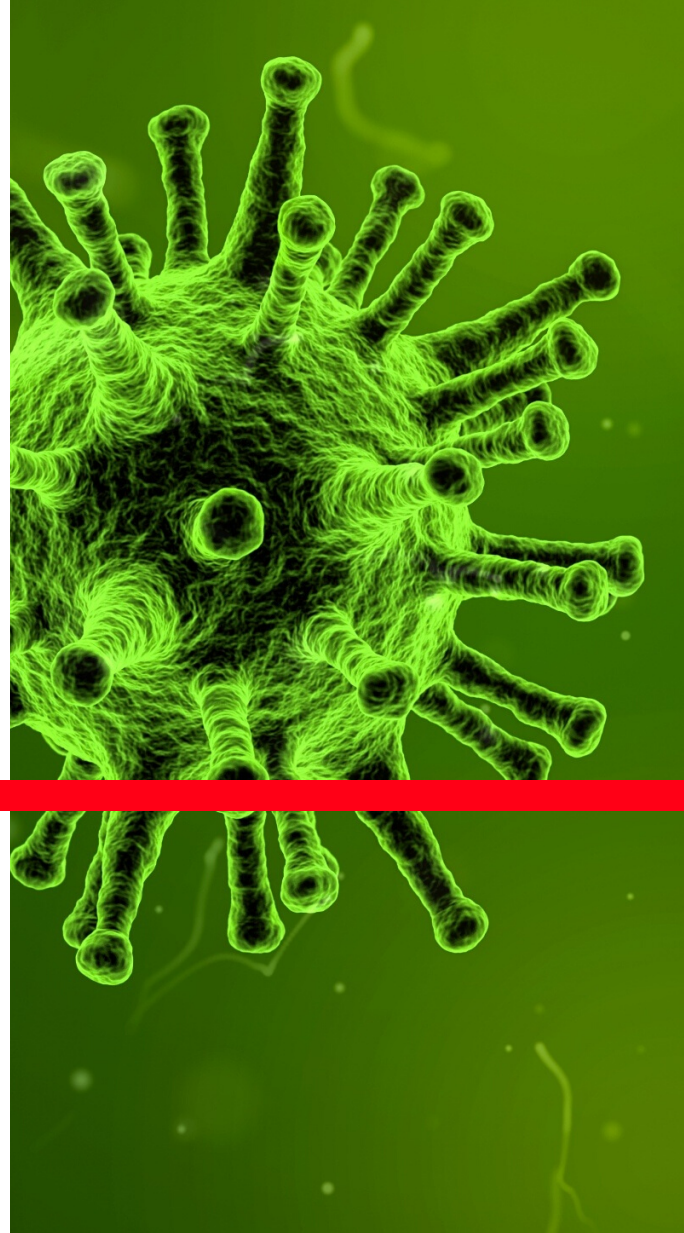
The electrostatic system we use places a positive charge on the liquid before entering the nozzle allowing the maximum levels of liquid to be charged and sprayed at negatively charged surfaces (most surfaces are either negative or neutral) allowing for a more complete coverage of the targeted surface.

What is the expected coverage?

The electrostatic system we use can cover up to 1,200 square metres on a single tank of fluid.
